10.15am: Arrive at the National Media Museum to a warm welcome from a museum Explainer who will confirm the details of your booking. They are easily identifiable by their red Learning T-shirts! They will show you where your lunch area and lockable storage trolley are located (if you've booked them in advance), confirm the time your group are booked in for lunch and give you your IMAX tickets (**please remember that these must be paid for before the day of your visit**).

10.30am: IMAX 3D Teacher's Choice

Be the first to book this early slot and you can choose which spectacular 3D IMAX film you want for your class – there are 5 short documentary-style films to select from. You'll need to have booked and paid at least 2 weeks before the date of your visit. Seeing a 3D IMAX film is like no other cinema experience and the action literally jumps out at you - don't be surprised to find yourself reaching out to touch! The price for this specially discounted screening is just £3.50 per pupil (usual price £4.50) and accompanying adults £1.



11.20am: Visit **The Magic Factory** on Level 4 – a hands-on, interactive gallery helping pupils to understand more about light, colour and shadows.

12.00pm: Time for lunch in one of our picnic areas - either the White Room on the ground floor or the Level 1 picnic space. Both seat groups of up to 30 and can be booked in advance.

12.30pm: Take a trip up to Level 3 and the fantastic **Experience TV** Gallery. Here you can discover how television is made, learn about the early pioneers of TV and find out what it feels like to read the news. Use our downloadable **Discover Experience TV** trail to help bring the objects to life.



1.30pm: Work your way down to the Lower Ground Floor to the **Kodak Gallery**. Find out about the birth of photography and the development of the camera, and discover just what part the Victorians played in making photography so accessible today. Download our **Discover the Kodak Gallery** trail to help you find out even more about the objects on display.

2.15pm: Visit the gift shop for some great souvenirs and pocket money gifts.

2.30pm: Time to leave the Museum after an exciting and fun-packed day!
